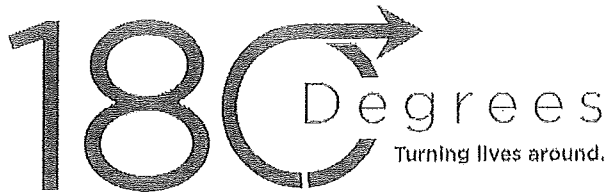
## 2018 Annual Prison Rape Elimination Act Report

**Purpose:** The Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) of 2003 was enacted to address sexual abuse, sexual assault and sexual harassment in confinement facilities. The goal of PREA is to prevent, detect and respond to sexual abuse in confinement facilities. 180 Degrees, Inc. supports all efforts to detect, report, investigate, and offer victim support services in an effort to prevent sexual assault, sexual abuse and sexual harassment.

This document serves as an annual review to assess and improve the effectiveness of the sexual abuse prevention, detection, and response of 180 Degrees, Inc. to national PREA Standards 115.287, 115.288 and 115.289. These standards require the organization to:

1. Collect accurate data, uniform data for every allegation of sexual abuse at facilities under its direct control using a standardized instrument and set of definitions.
2. Review and aggregate incident-based sexual abuse data annually in order to improve the effectiveness of sexual abuse prevention, detection and response policies, practices and training to include:
  - a. Identifying problem areas
  - b. Taking corrective action on an on-going basis; and
  - c. Preparing an annual report of its findings
3. Compare the current year's data and corrective actions with those from prior year's and provide an assessment of the agency's progress in addressing sexual abuse.
4. Publish the annual report on the organization's website with its findings and corrective actions for each facility and the agency as a whole.

For the year ended 2018, 180 Degrees facilities collected all incidences of the year as it relates to sexual allegations of sexual abuse, sexual misconduct and sexual harassment; concerning both offender-on-offender and staff on offender incidences.
